

What's New for Awards for 2021?

The highlights to the changes for the 2021 OADG Year-End Awards Criteria are listed below. For full details, please see the 2021 Awards Criteria document.

Reminder: Both Horse Owner and Rider must be members of the OADG for qualifying* scores to count towards Year End Awards.**

1. Both the Owner and Rider must be members of the OADG **by April 1st, 2021.**
2. The deadline to declare and submit your Team for the Team Challenge **April 1st, 2021.**
3. **Reminder:** Forms for Non-Scored Year End Awards are due before **October 10th, 2021:**
 - All forms for Year End Awards are to be submitted by email or mail to the Awards Director (*Volunteer, Horse Owner, Madison Crich Memorial Award*).
 - No form = no award.
4. **Reminder:** Forms for all Scored Year End Awards are due before **October 30th, 2021:**
 - All forms for Year End Awards are to be submitted by email or mail to the Awards Director (*PeeWee, Senior, Para- Rider, Young Horse, Team Challenge, and External Scores*)
 - No form = no award
 - Gold, Silver, and FEI are allowed only one (1) external score
5. Any scores from the 2020 show season can and will be added to the 2021 results
6. Please contact us if you have a change in status from 2020 i.e. PeeWee to JR or JR to AA
7. **Schooling Show Awards** - OADG will sponsor and award year-end medals for Schooling shows. The list of eligible shows is posted on the website www.ottawadressage.ca. The award criteria can be found in the Awards Document on the website as well.
8. **Team Challenge** - OADG will allow a team to be declared with four (4) horse/rider combinations - but only the top scores from three (3) horse/rider combinations can be submitted for awards.
9. **Silver Circuit** – The number of qualifying scores and shows a rider must have and competed at to be eligible for Year End Awards remains at three (3). Qualifying scores from Eastern Silver Championships may be used.
10. **Trophy Return** - The deadline for all trophy returns is on or before **September 19th** at the Eastern Ontario Silver Championships. This is to accommodate our engravers and provides them with ample time to prepare the trophies.
