- **open clinic with Melanie Bulmahn, certified Philippe Karl School of Légèreté instructor.** This is a very rare chance to ride with a licensed teacher from the School of Légèreté in Canada. The clinic is “open” which means any rider may participate. Unlike the School of Légèreté, riders need not apply and be accepted. Melanie is willing to work with all riders of all disciplines.

Philippe Karl is a French classical riding Master. He is a former ecuyer of the famous Cadre Noir. He is the author of the books “*The Twisted Truths of Modern Dressage*” and “*The Art of Riding Classical Dressage up to High School*”.  - -3 day clinic is \$725 (includes 3 rides and 1 lecture)

- A deposit of \$250 is due immediately to hold your spot. Full payment is due by July 3, 2013. A delicious catered lunch as well as dinner on the evening of the theory lesson will be available at a cost of \$10.00 per meal. Beverages and snacks will be available. Daytime and overnight stabling will also be available. Cost is \$25 per day or \$30 with overnight stabling.

Background

Melanie comes to us from Germany. She is one of Philippe Karl's top ranking certified instructors of the school of Légèreté (French for Lightness). She has been riding all of her life and teaching since 1990. Her holistic interests lead her to become an equine osteopathic therapist to compliment her continual study of Légèreté. Melanie's philosophy is to educate horses and riders in a sensible, healthy and anatomically correct way led by the classical art of riding of Philippe Karl. In her current work, she combines her medical background with the equestrian culture of Légèreté. Her goal is to provide a holistic training approach for horses and riders with the focus being respect for the horse. This provides a more intense dialogue between horse and rider where the horse is confident, light and at all times on the aids of the rider.
