## The Incredible Christilot Boylen

Christilot Boylen is a renowned Canadian dressage rider and coach with an illustrious career spanning over 50 years. Her dedication and talent in dressage was evident early on, leading her to become one of Canada's most accomplished riders and coaches.

Throughout her career, Christilot achieved numerous accolades and represented Canada at some of the worlds most prestigious international competitions. She competed in six Olympic Games (1964, 1968, 1972,1 976, 1984, and 1992) as a Canadian dressage team member. Christilot claimed a top-10 finish 7 times in the team competition, and 3 times in the individual competition. Her consistent performances at the highest level of the sport showcased her skill, dedication and love for dressage.

Beyond the Olympics, Christilot saw incredible success at the Pan American Games, where she achieved individual gold medals in 1971, 1975, and 1985. Her achievements brought recognition to Canadian dressage on the global stage and inspired aspiring equestrians in her homeland and beyond.

Not only is Christilot a talented rider, but she also contributed significantly to the sport's development in Canada. Boylen is the founder of Canadian Amateur Dressage Owners Association (CADORA), which to this day continues to serve the dressage community. She became an influential coach, sharing her expertise and knowledge with the next generation of riders. Her mentoring and coaching have helped many young dressage athletes in their pursuit of excellence. Christilot shares her success with her students who continue to perform at the highest level of international competition.

Christilot Boylen's unwavering passion for horses and dressage, combined with her remarkable achievements, have left a lasting legacy in the equestrian community. Her dedication to the sport and her role in promoting dressage in Canada have earned her respect and admiration from riders and enthusiasts worldwide. In 2019 Christilot was acknowledged by the Canadian Equestrian community when she was presented a lifetime achievement award by Equestrian Canada.
