- Memberships must be renewed with the OADG, CADORA Ontario and CADORA National no later than May 31st to retain voting privileges and ensure eligibility for all applicable awards.
- BOTH THE RIDER AND ONE OWNER* OF THE HORSE MUST join no later than May 31st in order to qualify for awards.

A membership in any level of OADG, CADORA Ontario or CADORA National is not required for a rider or horse to compete in dressage competitions. However; it is necessary for both the rider and at least one owner of the horse (if different) to be members by **May 31st** in order to be eligible for any year-end awards or competition grants sponsored by the OADG, CADORA Ontario or CADORA National.
