Membership Renewals: It is time to renew your OADG, CADORA Ontario, CADORA National membership for 2011. You receive one free CADORA Inc. Omnibus if you take out a full CADORA National membership (Senior or Junior). See the membership form attached to this newsletter for full membership information. The earlier you get your membership in, the more likely you are to receive the first mailing of the Omnibus.

The OADG will continue to issue membership cards to those members who take out a local only OADG membership or a CADORA Ontario membership. (Those members who take out a membership in CADORA National will receive a CADORA National membership card.)

Note: Memberships must be received by March 21st to ensure inclusion in the spring mailing of the 2011 Omnibus. After March 21st processing and mailing of membership information will be less frequent due to the limited number of memberships received and limited time available for the volunteers to process those memberships.

2010 OADG Award Winners: Congratulations to all the award winners! There were over 100 trophies, stall plaques, medallions, and cash awards given out at the OADG Awards Banquet for various Discovery, Silver, Gold, FEI, and Young Horse categories. In addition, there were special awards for Volunteer of the Year (Kiki Baggerman-Webster), Horse Owner of the Year (Cheryl Ogilvie), and the Dr. Brian Mills Top Junior Gold/FEI Award (Noémie Gagnon-Bergeron). 2010 – A Year In Review:

2010 was a banner year for attendance at the many horse shows around the Ottawa area. Many shows were full to capacity well before the closing dates. A great many sponsors have also become supportive of dressage in general. Many shows featured an abundance of prizes provided by their sponsors. We hope that this trend continues on into the future as this means there are many more people interested in the sport of dressage and we would all like to see dressage thrive. Other shows sites are becoming interested in supporting dressage shows which increases the opportunities our local dressage riders have to get out to more shows locally, and not have to ship to other areas of the province. Thank-you to all the show organizers from 2010 for doing a super job with the various horse shows.

The OADG had about 230 members in total by year-end, and hosted several events throughout the year. We had a full slate of directors which helps tremendously in the organization and running of events.

Our major accomplishments for 2010 included:

- Eddo Hoekstra clinic in the Spring. Eddo is now a regular clinician at several local barns in the area.
- Silver Dressage Championship Eastern Division was hosted by the OADG at Spiritwood Farm in North Gower. A super show despite the weather conditions with tremendous sponsorship support.
- OADG Awards Banquet held at the CedarHill Golf and Country Club with Guest Speaker Gerry Ogilvie.
- OADG AGM and Party.
- New merchandise with our Logo ordered late in the year. Watch for these items as prizes at local OEF Schooling shows in 2011.

One director, Susanne Vogt (Education Director), will not be continuing as an OADG director in 2011. Education for 2011 will be taken over by Caroline Anderson.

We welcome one new director for 2011, Laura-Lee Brenneman. She will be taking on the job of Secretary. Heather Snipper (Secretary in 2010) will continue to be the AGM Director for 2011.

Some other directors are changing their positions for 2011. Darlene Grant will be moving from Web Master, to Banquet for 2011. Cathy Gordon will remain as treasurer, but will take on the added role of Web Master and she has redesigned the OADG web site to a more up to date format. Caroline Anderson as already mentioned will be moving from Banquet to Education. Please see the list on the first page for your OADG directors for 2011.

Note that rules CAN and DO change throughout the show season, so check often for updates!

Also for 2011 there are **NEW TESTS!** There are now only 3 tests per level. Check them out on the Dressage Canada Website at: http://www.equinecanada.ca/index.php?option=com_docman&task=cat_view&gid=368&Itemid=365

Also new for 2011, judges may award ½ marks for technical or collective marks such as 6.5 or 5.5 or 7.5... See rule E9.8.14.

Confused? Lost? Then come out to the OADG Educate-Your-Eye and More clinic where it will all be made clear!

OADG Educate-Your-Eye and More Clinic: Mark your calendars for **Sunday April 10th 2011** for a preview of the new tests, and new rules at the OADG Educate-Your-Eye clinic. Not only will this clinic include the judge's perspective, but also a coach's perspective of the new tests. We will also have a Steward present to discuss some of those new rules that AFFECT YOU! Get Involved! The OADG makes several decisions regarding local awards, shows, clinics at its regular member meetings that affect you. DISCOVERY IS DEAD... you may have noticed in the local OADG show schedule that there are no longer shows designated as "DISCOVERY". Equine Canada has done away with Discovery shows. All references to "DISCOVERY" have been removed from the 2011 Equine Canada rule books. The OEF has stepped in with an **OEF Schooling Series**. The Dressage Canada tests can be used in OEF Schooling Series shows (up to First Level), so to those people riding in this circuit there will be **no discernable difference from previous Discovery shows**. The OEF Schooling Series shows organizers require a permit from the OEF, and competitors require an OEF membership to compete at these shows. Seems we have come full circle as this was the way these shows were run BEFORE the introduction of the Bronze/Silver/Gold designations.

Silver Dressage Championship Eastern Division: Rainbow Ridge Ranch will be hosting this show on September 11th 2011 in conjunction with the OADG. The judges have been announced as Lynda Southam and Marilyn Dietrich as appointed by CADORA Ontario.

CADORA Ontario Stephen Clarke Clinic May 14/15: Stephen Clarke will be returning in the spring this year for judging assignments and CADORA Ontario has setup a riding clinic with him for May 14/15 in Campbellville. Note that Stephen Clarke will be returning in the Fall for the regular CADORA Inc clinic, details will be announced by CADORA Inc.

Ted and Dorothy Leggett Tribute

The O.A.D.G. is saddened by the loss of two great contributors to dressage in the Ottawa area. Ted Leggett passed on August 28th in his 88th year and his sister Dorothy Leggett passed on Oct 16 in her 92nd year. Dorothy Leggett was a long time honorary member of the O.A.D.G..

Ted was one of the founders of the O.A.D.G. in 1964 (the others were Mr. and Mrs. H.C. Linkletter, Louise Barnes, and Tom Moore). When CADORA came into being in 1969, Ted refused to allow the O.A.D.G. to be absorbed into it. He felt that CADORA had yet to prove themselves, whereas, the O.A.D.G. had already done so. Ted's Copanspin Farm was one of three sites that held dressage shows in those early years. They were lucky to get 12 competitors per show. Ted continued to hold shows and support dressage in the area until 1974, when ill health forced him to walk away from most of the area horse scene. In later years, you could see him at some of the breeders' shows or at local farms measuring horses for the Canadian Hunter Association.

During this time, Dorothy worked in the background helping with the shows and even riding while she commuted from Kingston where she worked full time. Dorothy rode in the 1975 Ontario Dressage Championships held at Dwyer Hill Farms. She was also a Judge's Secretary (as scribes were called then) at the 1977 Canadian National Dressage Championships. Dorothy had a PHD in physical education and taught many teachers as well as students physical education. While she continued to teach in Kingston, she commuted back and forth to oversee affairs at Copanspin. Eventually, she retired and returned to run Copanspin and later Spindrift full time. She brought in outside clinicians for regular coaching and clinics. She also held a dressage show every year. She gave the O.A.D.G. a pile of trophies to use as annual awards. She loved the horses and really enjoyed seeing the upcoming young horses at her shows. And you cannot mention Dorothy without mentioning her love for her German Shepherds.

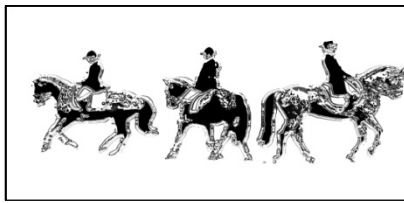
Let us remember and thank two great Ottawa horse personalities that helped bring dressage to where it is today.
