(Note, Birgit Valkenburg will be co-judging 3rd and 4th levels only at both the Eastern and Western Division shows. Her scores will be combined with those of the official judge to give a final score for each of the tests.)

Silver Dressage Championship Qualifying Rules: READ YOUR PRIZELIST for full information

- FORMAL: Two scores of 55% or higher from two different Silver competitions. (Separate Freestyle scores required to enter the freestyle classes.)
- INSUFFICIENT ENTRIES: Additional entries will be accepted provided the horse/rider has earned two scores of at least 50% from two different Silver competitions (Often used for the Eastern Division)
- OVER-ENTERED: Classes will be filled in descending order of the average of the qualifying scores of the technical tests submitted at the discretion of the show committee.

Note that all scores earned at the Silver Dressage Championship Eastern Division can be used towards OADG Silver year-end awards! Don't miss out!

EYE Clinic

So way back in the spring we had an Educate your eye clinic, this was the first one we have had in a few years. As an auditor I would say the place, Benhaven, was very nice, good viewing area, nice footing, and good light as all Coverall buildings do. The clinicians were great at working together. This was the first time we had both a judge and a coach. So the judge, Joan MaCartney would make her comments on the test, and then the coach Kirsten Blaeski would help the rider to resolve the problems. This worked very well and I hope we do it this way again. It gave the clinicians a chance to improve certain aspects of the test and explain to the rider and auditors what was going on, why, how to fix it, and when things were corrected. Much of problems the coach addressed were regarding head position and relaxation. Everything was done in a positive tone, with the aim at improving. Many horses were tense and so some of the comments reflected this. My daughter's four year old Friesian cross, held all his tension in his neck so it was good that Kirsten worked on relaxing him and lowering his neck. We also had the opportunity to see the differences between the levels with some demonstration riders who showed us movements from level "X" and then proceeded to show the same movements from level "X+1" where more collection and smaller figures were required. It was overall a very informative day.

Huntingford is a beautiful facility, and it was the perfect venue for my first Gold show. Everyone helping out at the Show was very friendly, and the low key, quiet atmosphere really helped to settle both of our nerves. Best of all, the photographer on site took some lovely pictures of my so clean white mare against the bright green hedges and fields surrounding the ring. And yes, the pictures showed that our goal of perfect harmony is within reach!
