Open Positions for 2013

There are several open positions coming up for 2013. If you are interested in a position don't wait till the last minute as positions do tend to fill up before the actual AGM, although an election for a position can be held at the AGM. Communications Director: The communications director is responsible for creation of 5 newsletters per year which would include getting interesting articles (such as an Officials Bio, or the Stewards Corner, or clinic write-ups, or reprinting with permission other information), including the remaining show list in the newsletter, writing the Board section, finding pictures that could be included, and anything else you can think of to make the newsletter a bit more fun. The communications director is also responsible for sending out timely newsbriefs to the OADG members with show updates, clinic updates, rule updates and other information the OADG members may need to be aware of between full newsletters.

Awards Director: This job requires updating the awards criteria in spring, and having it approved by the OADG board of directors. Updating all the forms necessary for the members to use in the fall for applying for the various awards. Getting people to help track the scores from all the local shows through-out the summer so the winners can be easily determined in the fall. In the fall, collecting all the trophies from the previous year's winners and getting those trophies to the engraver. Determining all the winners for the year based on the scores that were tracked over the summer, and forms that have been submitted. Posting all the award winners on the OADG website, and creating the awards booklet for the banquet. Setting up of the trophies at the awards banquet and help the presenters give them out. If you have a good team of helpers this job goes very smoothly.

Promotions: Find products on the various distributor websites that may be of interest to our members or as prizes at shows. Come up with a cost estimate for discuss with the OADG board of directors, and finally order the products that are selected. Work on a display that can be used at local shows to garner interest in the OADG and find people to help man the OADG display at local shows.

Banquet: Find and book a suitable location for the OADG year-end awards banquet. Arrange for entertainment during the evening of the banquet, and arrange for a Master of Ceremonies for the evening of the banquet. In September, with the help of the treasurer, set the banquet ticket price and have it approved by the OADG board of directors, and create the banquet poster and banquet ticket order form. Sell the banquet tickets. Organize centerpieces for the banquet tables. Create the seating plan and schedule for the evening of the banquet. Greet people at the door during the banquet and ensure the evening runs according to plan.

You can also contest for positions which are currently filled and an election will be held at the AGM. To contest for a position you need to be a current Senior OADG member, you must be nominated by another current OADG Senior member, and your nomination must be seconded by yet another current OADG Senior member. You must also provide a short write-up of your skills related to the position. Nominations (and skills write-up) can be in advance, sent to Kiki Baggerman-Webster, or can be at the AGM itself.

Most of the current OADG directors hold full time jobs outside the horse industry, have family obligations, ride their horse(s) and still manage to make some time for the OADG. Who is Pierre M. Paquette ?

Pierre is a retired lawyer of the federal department of Justice. He has been involved in the equestrian sport since the late 1980's as a rider, competitor and horse owner in the hunter, jumper and dressage disciplines. He presently owns 3 horses, Serenity (17 year old, Hanoverian/Belgium warm-blood, retired from competition 4 years ago, at level 4, due to injury), Don Noir (10 year old, Hanoverian, competing presently at level four) and Cody (an 11 year old, miniature pony). Don Noir is ridden by his daughter Isabelle who has been riding for the last 23 years. He is a member of the following riding associations, namely Equine Canada, Dressage Canada, CADORA National and Ontario, Ottawa Area Dressage Group and Eastern Ontario Pleasure Driving Society.

Pierre has been a member of the O.A.D.G. for a number of years and has held the position of O.A.D.G. CADORA Ontario representative, and presently he is also the Award Director. He also acted as MC at the Award banquet. He followed the Equine Canada Competition Organizers Clinic in 2011. He has been president of the Seignior Club in Montebello P.Q., of the Buckingham Curling Club and of the Rivermead Golf Club. Although he recognizes that these latter clubs were not equestrian type, he believes that it has provided him with great experience in administering successfully benevolent entities.

These are Pierre's goals as chairperson of the O.A.D.G. To promote the O.A.D.G. in the greater Ottawa area and to make known to the local communities the usefulness of the equestrian sport and in particular the discipline of dressage as well as emphasize to barn owners and show organizers how the O.A.D.G. can be of help to them. To promote the merits of horsemanship to the parents of the young generation and the positive impact that it can have in the character building of their children. To ensure that the O.A.D.G. can achieve its goals at the lowest costs possible and be able to provide a full profit return to all of its members. Within the financial means available to the group, pursue educational equestrian ventures and information sessions that can help all members, young or old, pleasure riders, competitors, officials, show organizers or parents to better understand the different aspects of the dressage discipline and its governing rules and bodies To ensure that the benevolent officials of the O.A.D.G. are fully recognized for the time and effort they spend working for the group and that the tasks to be done do not become too cumbersome and disturbing to their own private lives.

All of these can be achieved by focusing on streamlining, clarifying and simplifying the main goals of the OADG, namely, information/education, show scheduling, rules, as well as the year end banquet and by using new technology and approaches where applicable and feasible.

Finally, he has the spare time and energy to make this task a serene and successful one for all concerned.

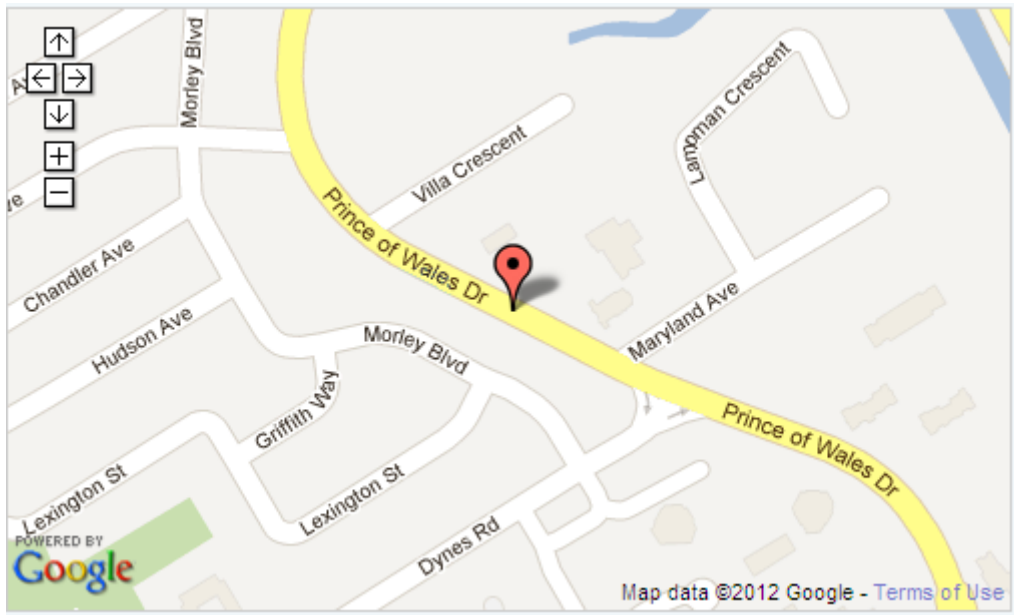

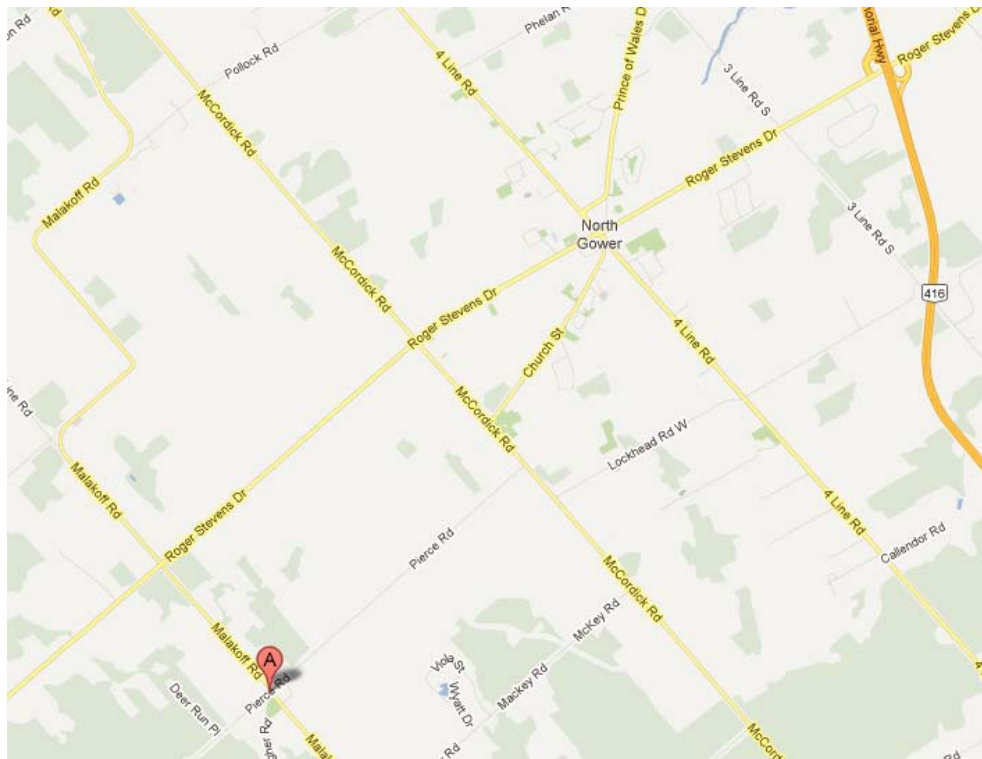
