Awards & Forms....

Not everyone needs to send in a form this year for year-end awards, but some of you do... Forms ARE REQUIRED by October 10th for:

- All CDI/FEI show scores (Form at the end of the newsletter and on the OADG website)
- Gold and Silver show scores for shows outside of the Ottawa area (Form at the end of the newsletter and on the OADG website)
- The OEF Schooling PeeWee award (Form at the end of the newsletter and on the OADG website) Special awards for all show levels including:
- Young Horse Award (OEF Schooling, Silver and Gold) (Form on OADG website)
- Horse Owner of the Year Award (Form on OADG website)
- Volunteer of the Year Award (Form on OADG website)
- Senior Rider of the Year (Form on the OADG website)

Forms are **NOT** required for JR/AA/O OEF Schooling show scores, JR/AA/O SILVER show scores and JR/AA/O GOLD show scores for shows in the Ottawa area.

Don't forget about the PeeWee Award for local OEF Schooling riders 10 and under! If you (or someone you know) competed in OEF Schooling shows in the Ottawa area in 2012 and is 10 years old and under they are eligible for this award. You (and the owner of the horse) are **NOT** required to be an OADG member in 2012, however you must send in the form so we know who you are.

All forms are now available on the OADG website in pdf and word format. The form" 2012 Scores Submission Gold/FEI/Silver circuit awards" is included in this newsletter. Forms for Young Horse, Horse Owner of the Year, Volunteer of the year and Senior Rider of the year are available on the OADG website: www.ottawadressage.ca. If you cannot send in the forms by October 10th, please contact the awards director Pierre Paquette. Forms and extensions requests should be emailed to Pierre Paquette awards@ottawadressage.ca.

Awards Criteria: The full awards criteria was included in the March newsletter, and is available on our website. Scores from the entered division from the Silver Dressage Championship Eastern Division are used as qualifying scores for local OADG awards!!!!

Also, for CADORA Inc. National members' eligible for CADORA Inc. National Awards, you are required to send in a form to the CADORA Inc. awards co-ordinator by December 1st to be eligible for these awards. 2012 OADG Awards Criteria Highlights

(Changes for 2012 are in **bold** characters)

Owner and Rider of the Horse must be OADG members on **July 1**st, **2012.** The only exception is the Peewee Award for riders 10 and under where membership is not required.

If owner and rider participate in a show prior to July 1^{st} , 2012 and are not members of the OADG but so become before July 1^{st} , any show they attended in May will be included retroactively in the official show results for 2012.

PeeWees are eligible for the Junior awards if they are OADG members.

The show name of a horse may be changed or modified during the course of the season. However, for the scores of the team (horse-rider) to count as the same team, the owner MUST advise the Award Director in writing or by e-mail of the change of name BEFORE the horse is entered in another competition. Failure to do so, will result in the new scores being counted as a new and separate team.

Only Equine Canada approved tests are eligible for OADG Awards. The only exceptions are the CADORA Walk/Trot tests used for W/T Rider and W/T Horse classes, and the Training Level Freestyle test as there is no Equine Canada freestyle available at this level.

Scores from one circuit (i.e. Gold) cannot be counted towards another circuit (i.e. Silver). If more than one judge judges the same ride, the average of the scores of the judges will be counted as the official score.

Scores from 'Special Request' classes at OEF Schooling Shows will not be counted towards Year End Awards.

A schooling show must be an official OEF ESD Permit Schooling Show to be recognized for Year End Awards.

A rider must actually ride in a class for the score to count for OADG awards. (For example, the score received by a rider in an AA class cannot also count as a score at the same level in Open.)

If a rider is the year end Champion or Reserve champion in the OEF Schooling as well as in the Silver or Gold Circuit (i.e. Training level in both OEF Schooling and Silver) the OADG Year End Award will only be given for the higher Circuit (in the example, Silver). If the rider is the year end Champion or Reserve Champion in the Silver and Gold Circuit, the rider will win both awards.

Year End Award forms (if required) must be received by the OADG Awards Director **by October 10, 2012.** Specific criteria for each award are outlined in the <u>Table</u> on the OADG website

Equine Health Corner

Equipment Recall

English Riding Supply, Inc., is voluntarily recalling about 3,400 Happy Mouth Wire Mouth Bits after receiving four reports that wires contained in the bits had broken, resulting in possible rider injuries. The reported rider injuries include broken and fractured bones and back pain from falls allegedly attributed to bit failure during use. The recalled bits were manufactured in Korea and sold in the United States nationwide between July 2003 and April 2012.

Michael Diamond of the English Riding Supply, Inc., marketing department said that braided steel wire contained the mouthpiece that connects the bit on either side of the horse's cheeks can become frayed, rusted or worn, causing the bit to break, and compromising the rider's ability to control the horse.

Eight models of the Happy Mouth Wire Bits are included in the recall. Recalled bits have model numbers 462172SS, 462177SS, 462181SS, 462184SS, 464123SS, 466898SS, 466904SS and 467248SS. Model numbers can be found on a label attached to the product. "Happy Mouth" is engraved on the plastic mouthpiece.

Horse owners should stop using the recalled bits immediately and return them to the retailer or directly to English Riding supply for a refund.
