**Entries:** Close Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at midnight

**Mail or e-mail entries to the secretary or drop off the entries at the farm or the secretary.**

**Note:** Inaugural Show. There will be **no (\$0.00)** administration fee.

**Cheques** should be made payable to ‘Stevens Creek Farm’ and must be dated no later than the closing date. Post-dated cheques are not acceptable. There will be a charge of \$30.00 for returned cheques. Payment may also be made by e-transfer to [scfsecretary100@gmail.com](mailto:scfsecretary100@gmail.com); use ‘stevenscreek’ as the security password.

**Substitutions** (horse or rider) may be made with the Show Secretary before the class starts. Late entries after the closing date will be charged a \$20.00 late fee and will be accepted only if entry information is complete, and there is sufficient remaining space in the competition. Add-On Division – speak to show secretary.

**Scratches and Refunds:** If entry is withdrawn before closing date, entry fee will be refunded. After closing date, no refund except with vet or medical certificate, less \$30 admin fee.

**Horses may compete in a maximum of four tests in one day at two consecutive levels, including the corresponding Freestyle Class. More than one rider may ride the same horse/pony at a competition providing the horse/pony is not entered by two or more riders in the same class, and that there are not more than four tests by any single horse.**

**Freestyles:** Two working copies of the freestyle music must be provided (on CD's).

**Hors Concours:** Hors concours entries allowed, and will be accepted if there is room.

**Riding Times:** Times will be posted on the OADG website and Stevens Creek Farm Facebook Page by Friday, May 27<sup>th</sup>. Facebook Group: [www.facebook.com/StevensCreekFarm/](http://www.facebook.com/StevensCreekFarm/)

**Prizes:** Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Ribbons sponsored by Adda'Go Equestrian, home of Manners Manner. There will be a Champion and Reserve Champion awarded per level on the completion of all tests in that level when two tests ridden. No Champion or Reserve Champion awards will be given where there are not at least two competitors at the level in question.

**Stabling:** Limited overnight, off-site, please contact organizer/secretary

**Directions: From Hwy 416 North or South:** Exit Roger Stevens Drive, go east ½ km, first left (north) on Second Line Rd. Go 1 km. First farm on right immediately after small bridge.

**Hwy 417 alt route:** Exit Hwy 417 at Boundary Rd go south 1.5 km, turn right (west) on Mitch Owens Rd. and continue for 21.8 km. Turn left (south) onto River Rd and go for 9.6 km. Right onto Roger Stevens Dr. for 3.6 km, and right (north) onto Second Line Road, Go 1 km. First farm on right immediately after small bridge.

## **Equine Canada Dressage Show – General Rules & Conditions**

**Statement of Principles:** Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

All Persons shall be committed to:

- upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;
- continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions; and
- actively promoting the development of and adherence to competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

**Rules:** Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. All competitors are responsible for knowing these rules ([www.equinecanada.ca](http://www.equinecanada.ca)).

**Decisions:** Every class offered herein is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with said Rules and Specifications. Judges' and Stewards' decisions are final. Questions not covered by the EC Rules and Specification shall be addressed and decided upon by the Show Committee, and their decision will be final.

**Liability:** Stevens Creek Farm, its owners, employees and volunteers will not be held liable or responsible for any loss, damage or injury incurred to any person or animal, or for any damage to vehicles, trailers or other property while on Stevens Creek Farm premises.

**Safety Headgear:** All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear properly fitted and fastened safety approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any Equine Canada sanctioned Dressage competition at the Event location.

**Insurance:** Competitors are responsible for all insurance to themselves, employees, owners and horses, etc. All owners and trainers/coaches are responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events, including those outside your province of residence, is strongly recommended. For Ontario residents, insurance is provided through OEF membership.

**Other:** The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any person or horse, and to govern all conditions specific to the show. The Show Committee further reserves the right to cancel or change a class, and to limit entries.

- All Canadian entries (Silver Show) are required to hold both a current EC passport and a valid EC horse license to compete. If a horse is owned by a Temporary Sport License holder, a temporary horse registration form must be purchased as each competition entered (such forms may be purchased from the Show Secretary). Foreign entries must sign an affidavit (see E.C. General Rules A404). Passports and horse licenses are available from Equine Canada (308 Legget Drive, Suite 101, Ottawa, Ontario, K2K 1Y6).
- Passports with valid 2016 EC horse license sticker must be handed in to the show secretary before competition numbers will be issued and the horse is allowed to compete (Silver participants). Passports will be returned to the competitor when the competition number is returned to the show secretary.
- Horses are required to have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test, a valid copy of which must be submitted with each entry.
- Both owner and rider must be members in good standing with Ontario Equestrian Federation (OEF) or their PSO (all competitors), and with Equine Canada and Dressage Canada (Silver Show). Copies of all required memberships must be submitted with the show entry.
- Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times while on show grounds by the horse or handler, for identification by officials. Competitions numbers will be available from the show secretary at the designated tent, upon arrival.
- Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication drug control testing while at the event location.
- Silver Show: All riders must report, still mounted, to the steward immediately following their test for a tack check. Failure to report will result in elimination from that class. The rider may not remove any equipment or clothing before the inspection, nor may handlers remove any tack from the horse.
- Regular dressage tests can be located in the Dressage Canada 2016 Handbook or can be located via: (<http://www.ottawadressage.ca/tests/>). Eventing dressage tests are from 2016 and can be found at: ([http://www.equinecanada.ca/index.php?option=com\\_docman&gid=470](http://www.equinecanada.ca/index.php?option=com_docman&gid=470)).
- Schooling is not permitted at any time in the competition ring area. Lungeing (unmounted) is permitted in designated outdoor lunging areas only. Warm-up is restricted to designated warm-up areas only. Under no circumstances shall lungeing be permitted in warm-up areas.
- Dogs and other pets are discouraged. If you must bring your dog it must be well behaved and on a leash at all times. Dogs are not allowed in the warm-up areas or the competition rings. The show committee reserves the right to ask any individual to remove their dog or other pet(s) from the premises.
- Unless actually competing, no mounted riding is permitted in a competition ring.

No smoking is allowed in any of the buildings, show office or in competition and warm-up areas.
