## Entries

**Closing date:** Saturday, May 27, 2017 at midnight.

**Payment:** By cash, e-transfer or cheque, made payable to **Westar Farms**.

Save \$5 in admin fees by entering online @ showmate.net (it is a very user friendly system, but if you need any assistance, just let us know).

There will be a charge of \$40 for returned cheques.

**Late entries** (after the closing date) will be charged a late fee and will be accepted only if there is sufficient remaining space in the competition.

**Add-On Division:** Speak to show secretary.

**Substitutions** (horse or rider) may be made with the Show Secretary before the class starts.

**Scratches and Refunds:** If entry is withdrawn before closing date, entry fee will be refunded minus a \$10 fee. After closing date, no refund except with vet or medical certificate, (or if space can be filled) less administration fee.

**Riding Times:** Times will be posted on the OADG website and Westar Farms Facebook Page by Wednesday, May 31.

**Hors Concours:** Hors concours entries allowed, and will be accepted if there is room.

Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

Champion and Reserve Champion awarded at every level with at least 3 competitors.

Classes will be split for awards if sufficient entries. i.e. more than 3 at each Level: Junior, Amateur and Open

## **Silver Dressage Show Rules & Regulations**

---

1. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. All competitors are responsible for the knowledge of these rules. The show committee reserves the right to govern all conditions of the show. Questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the show committee and steward and their decisions will be final. The show committee further reserves the right to cancel or change any class and to limit entries.
2. The Westar Farms competition is sanctioned as a Silver competition member of Equine Canada, and is governed in accordance with the EC Rule book. All Canadian entries are required to hold an EC Horse Recording and have paid the annual activation fee to compete, or if owned by a Temporary Sport License holder, a Temporary Horse Registration form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an Affidavit (general rule A602.05) Passports must be handed to the show secretary before horses will be allowed to compete.
3. Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Person Responsible (PR) must sign the competition entry form. PR must be an EC Sport License holder in good standing OR in the case of junior/minor owner entries, a parent/guardian is entitled to sign as PR. Do not participate in this EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition. (A602.7).
4. Riders and Owners are required to be members of the OEF or other PSO. In addition, a minimum of EC Silver Competitive License is required for both owners and. You may contact the OEF for an application form.
4. A copy of a current negative 2017 Coggins test for each horse entered must be presented at show office before picking up competition number.
5. All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition must wear properly filled and fastened approved protective head gear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location (E.4.0.)
6. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds, be selected for Equestrian medication control testing.
7. Horses may compete in a maximum of 4 technical tests in one day at 2 consecutive levels, including the corresponding Freestyle Class. Competitors must wear their competition number at all times on the show grounds.
8. Competitors must have achieved 55% in one technical test at the appropriate level, either at a previous show or the current show, to be eligible to enter a freestyle class. Under Dressage Rule E10.3.4, please provide 2 functioning copies of your Freestyle music that can be played on a CD player and not a computer or tape machine.
9. Lunging permissible only in assigned areas.

## **Equestrian Canada Statement of Principle**

---

Equestrian Canada (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors, and their agents use responsible care in handling, treatment, and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on Equestrian health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers, and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.
- Per Article A801, every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, coach, agent, driver, lessee, manager, driver, rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted Equestrian training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

## ESD Dressage Show Information

The following information is provided in addition to that listed on page 1.

The Westar Farms Equestrian Skills Development Show (ESD) is a provincially sanctioned show under the rules of Equestrian Canada.

**ESD Riders and Owners** are required to be members of the OEF or other PSO.

Horses may compete in a maximum of 4 technical tests in one day at 2 consecutive levels, including the corresponding Freestyle Class.

**Test of Choice (TOC):** Any current OADG, EC (Training and First Levels only), CADORA, or Canadian Eventing Test or a breed-specific test. You can use these shows to practice for a forthcoming competition, to try upgrading, or for your experience. Please specify test and arena size on Entry Form.

**Freestyle:** Solo, Pas de Deux or Quadrille. EC first Level Freestyle; CADORA Freestyles; Novice (W/T) Freestyles. Please specify test and arena size on Entry Form.

**Walk/Trot Riders** are in their first or second year of showing in dressage classes and are not permitted to enter classes that require them to canter.

**Green Horses** are in their first or second year of showing. Restricted to Juniors and amateurs.

Tack to be in accordance with EC rules. Horses may wear boot/bandages; whips may be carried.

**Juniors** are competitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of January 1, 2016.

**PeeWee:** Please indicate Junior rider's age on entry form. A competitor is eligible for the OADG year-end PeeWee Award until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 years old.

If entries warrant classes will be split into PeeWee, Junior, Adult Amateur and Open.

**Championship awards:** Walk/Trot Division ~ calculated based on classes 101 – 103. Points for class 103 to be calculated as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>: 5 points, 2<sup>nd</sup>: 4, 3<sup>rd</sup>:3, 4<sup>th</sup>: 2, 5<sup>th</sup>: 1 and will be added to percentage scores from classes 101 and 102.

Green Horse championship calculated from results of class 104 – 106 as above.

Training and First Level championships based on your best scores in two of the three tests available at each level.
